JOB PURPOSE:

To provide pastoral support and care on a 1-1 basis with young people

KEY ACTIVIES

- 1. To establish positive, interactive relationships with young people
- 2. To meet young people where they are at, listening well, and empowering and supporting young people to make a successful transition into adulthood
- 3. To support young people to overcome individual, spiritual, social, educational and emotional barriers, meeting the holistic needs of young people.
- 4. To provide pastoral care, prayer and biblical wisdom and understanding to the situations, challenges and circumstances presented.
- 5. To explore root causes of issues presented, liaising with youth team for further support and referring on to specialist support agencies as required
- 6. To monitor the progress of each mentee and document sessions as required
- 7. Follow best safeguarding practice, and all relevant policies and procedures.
- 8. To engage in regular support and supervision through the youth team

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

To be typically worked outside of normal school hours. Flexibility to work evenings and weekends.

A minimum criteria for all office volunteers, would be that they attend a Life Group and the Life Group leader is able to provide a reference. However, due to the nature of this role, you would also need to be a Committed Member and deemed suitable for working with children.
