- A colouring book

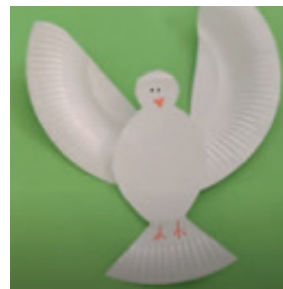
'JESUS BRINGS PEACE' CRAFT
