

BALLOON RACE

Craft - Pentecost fire spinner!



Using red and yellow card or paper, cut 2 squares, the same size, then stick them together.

If you don't have coloured paper, use white paper and decorate it.

Fold the square in half to make a triangle shape, then in half again.

Make cuts from one point to the other, but not all the way.

Leave about 0.5 cm between each line.

Open it up and separate your strips.

Attach a piece of cotton, string or fishing wire.

Why not hang it up near to a window, to remind you of when the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost!
