Welcome to the Prayer Shield!

We are so glad you are checking out the Prayer Shield. As a church and as a youth ministry, we believe that prayer is important and exciting: it is how we can connect with and talk to God. Through prayer we have seen salvation and God's blessings poured out in the lives of many young people, helping them connect to God in new ways, and so we commit to press into God through prayer!

We can be involved with praying the Prayer Shield over ourselves, our families and over one another, including our LifeGroups, our friends and our leaders. We believe that as we continue to pray for God's will to be done, that God will transform our lives and the lives of those around us. That out of us will flow the Spirit of God and we will see lives transformed.

This booklet contains more about what the Prayer Shield is and how you can use it to help you pray. There is a specific topic to pray for each day of the week (maybe spend 10-15 minutes doing this). Also there is 'The Lord's Prayer', and 'The Prayer of Jabez', to use as examples of prayer and to help you engage with God more than ever.

It could also help to write down your prayers along with when they are answered as this can be a great way to remind yourself of God's faithfulness!

Let's unite together to pray for God to move in us and through us in this season.



What is the Prayer Shield?

The idea of the Prayer Shield is based on Paul's teachings about spiritual warfare and putting on the armour of God in Ephesians 6:10-20. Paul tells us to "take up the shield of faith" so we "can extinguish the flaming arrows of the evil one" (Ephesians 6:16). Like the roman soldiers would lift up their shields and put them together, we want to lift up our own shields of faith over ourselves but also over each other!

In Ephesians 6:18 Paul tells us to "Pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this is mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people".

When we pray for each other we lift up our shield of faith, bringing in God's protection and God's purposes for our lives, and for the world around us.



SUNDAY

PRAY FOR OUR FRIDAY YOUTH AND SUNDAY SERVICES:

- "Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshippers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks."
- JOHN 4:23
- "I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better."
- EPHESIANS 1:17
- "...give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching your word. Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus, "After this prayer, the meeting place shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. - Pray that our hearts will be open as we worship and engage with God's word
- Pray that people won't be distracted but focused fully on God
- Pray for heaviness, anxiety and depression to be lifted as we worship
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will help us understand God's word and that we can apply it practically in our own lives
- Pray for the power and presence of God to meet with all those present
- Pray for lives to be transformed
- Pray for healings and miracles as we gather together
- Pray for those who become Christians for the first time and for those who re-commit their lives to God again, that they would all know how much God loves them.
- Pray for a strong sense of community and relationship with all

- Take notes while listening to the preach to help you focus

MONDAY

PRAY FOR HEALTH AND PROTECTION

- "Worship the Lord your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you... I will give you a full life span."
- EXODUS 23:25-26
- "But those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wing like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint."

- Pray for health and protection over the people around you
- Pray specifically for those who are ill, that they will get their health and strength back
- Pray that we can both study and rest well, full of energy, creativity and life
- Pray that we will all be able to sleep well
- Pray for God's protection, that any plans the enemy has will not work
- Pray for safety and peace for yourself and those around you

- Ask God for an encouragement or scripture to share with someone you know who is unwell
- Ask a friend if there is anything you can pray for them

THURSDAY

- HEBREWS 10:24-25






- Pray that we will all be empowered and strengthened by the Holy Spirit

- MATTHEW 28:19




- Pray that we will demonstrate the love and goodness of God to those around us

The Prayer of Jabez

"Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, 'Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge me territory! Let your hand be with me, and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain.' And God granted his request."

There are four main parts to this prayer:

1. "Oh, that you would bless me"

Thank God for His blessing, pray for more blessings in your life and the lives of those around you!

2. "Enlarge my territory"

Pray for God to enlarge your influence! Pray that you will have more opportunities to show God's goodness and love to people.

3. "Let your hand be with me"

Pray for anointing, that God will release His power in your life. Pray that we are pushed out of our comfort zone for God so that we become more dependant on Him!

4. "Keep me from harm"

Pray for God's protection in your life. Ask God to help us understand that we are in His hands and are cared for by Him.
