

Prayer Time

We communicate in lots of different ways, we can call somebody on the telephone, speak to them face to face, or even write them a letter.

Why don't you spend some time today, writing a letter to God as a way of expressing your prayer to him? You could start by using the ideas from the prayer video clip:

P–Praise, start by praising God, tell him how amazing he is and why you love him.

R–Repent, tell God you are sorry for things you may have done that do not show that you love him.

A–Ask God, this is where you can ask him to heal those that are sick or to help some of our key workers.

Y–Yield, listen to God, he will spak to you when you give him time and space, tell him that you are listening and ready to obey.
