

DO IT

In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.

- JAMES 2:17 NIV

- Are there things that the Lord has asked you to do but for some reason you've not done them? Taking steps of obedience, however small, helps to unlock and activate faith. Ask God for wisdom and courage to step out in faith.
- Be in faith that your actions will produce much good fruit in your life and in the lives of those around you.

WAIT FOR IT

We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

- HEBREWS 6:12 NIV

- Ask God for patience while you're waiting for His promises to be fulfilled. Be determined not to grow weary.
- Do everything you know to keep faith alive and active in your spirit - keep meditating on scriptures and share with trusted people what you're believing God to do. Ask them to stand in faith with you while you wait.

PRAYER POINTS FOR THE DAY:

- Pray for a fresh outpouring of God's Spirit across the nation; for His revival power to sweep across the land.
- Pray for all those in authority, especially for our government and those in opposition. Pray for godly men and women to be appointed into positions of influence, helping to shape our nation's future in the coming years.

FAITH

WELCOME

As we head into 2020, we want to position ourselves, once again, in a posture of prayer with fasting, to seek God and declare His kingdom to come and His will to be done on earth as it is in heaven. Throughout this prayer guide you will see Mark 11:22-24 repeated in different translations. It's an audacious challenge from Jesus to take hold of the promises of God and to command any obstacles that are stopping them from being fulfilled to be gone! In the previous verse, Jesus also reminds us to deal with any unforgiveness in our lives as it hinders our prayers from being answered. So, as we head into these next three days, let's start by asking God to purify our hearts and then, humbly but boldly, ask God for breakthrough in our lives, our families, our communities and the nation(s).

Jesus replied, "Let the faith of God be in you! Listen to the truth I speak to you: If someone says to this mountain with great faith and having no doubt, 'Mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the midst of the sea,' and believes that what he says will happen, it will be done. This is the reason I urge you to boldly believe for whatever you ask for in prayer - be convinced that you have received it and it will be yours."

HEAR IT

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

- ROMANS 10:17 NKJV

- Think about situations that you need a breakthrough in, such as an area of healing, provision, wisdom or direction. Then find scriptures that will help to release faith into that situation. There are some great free online resources to help you. See the back page for more details.
- Write those scriptures down so that you have a record and can keep going back to them. Set aside time to meditate on them until faith begins to rise in your spirit.

KNOW IT

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

- HEBREWS 11:1 NIV

- Surrender your will to God, then ask Him to show you His will for your life. Be sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and commit to doing what He says.
- Ask Him for a gift of faith so that you can 'know' that your prayer is being answered or that His promise is being fulfilled in your life, ahead of a change of circumstances.

PRAYER POINTS FOR THE DAY:

- Pray for all those attending Alpha; that their eyes would be opened to the truth of who God is - that He loves them and sent Jesus to die for them so that they can come to know Him as their Heavenly Father.
- Pray for unusual demonstrations of God's power to be released and for stories of miraculous healing which testify of His great love for His people.

SAY IT

"Have faith in God," Jesus answered. "Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them.

- MARK 11:22-23 NIV

- What you speak out loud often helps to shape your thoughts and actions. So, declare God's Word and His promises over yourself, situations or people who need a breakthrough. Break the power of fear and unbelief by declaring the truth of who God is; He is good, He is a mighty saviour, healer and deliverer.
- Set aside some time to worship, declaring God's rule and reign over your life and of the lives of those around you.

PRAYER POINTS FOR THE DAY:

- Pray for all our KingsGate centres; that they would continue to flourish and grow.
- Pray especially for KingsGate Leicester and London as they head into this season in new venues. Pray for a wonderful mix of people to be added, for strong relationships to be formed and for people to find a spiritual home to put down roots in.

Jesus replied, "Have faith in God [constantly]. I assure you and most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!' and does not doubt in his heart [in God's unlimited power], but believes that what he says is going to take place, it will be done for him [in accordance with God's will]. For this reason, I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God's will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you."
