When we face difficulties, it is natural to feel fearful, but in these times, we can remember that **God is with us**.

The opposite of fear is faith. Faith is trusting that God is with us and that He helps us and protects us; God is faithful.


- Make a list of the times God has been faithful to you and your family and keep it to read when you need to be reminded of God's faithfulness.

MORE BIBLE STORIES TO READ TOGETHER

Check out these Bible stories to hear how God helped people when they put their trust in God when they were afraid.

When we are afraid, our God is always with us too!

David and Goliath – 1 Samuel 17: 1-53. God's people, the Israelites, were terrified of the giant, but God came to their rescue!

Gideon is sent to save God's people – Judges 6: 11-14, 23-24. An angel gives Gideon a special job to do for God.

Mary and the Angel Gabriel – Luke 1:26-30. The angel tells Mary not to be afraid and tells her of God's amazing rescue plan for the whole world.

Jesus tells us to not worry – Matthew 6:25-34. Let's trust Jesus to take us safely through this difficult time – He cares for us and is with us.

PRAYER AND PRAISE

Pray together, using this prayer as a guide:

"Dear God, thank you for being in control. Help me to be brave and wise when things are scary. Help me to put my trust in you. In Jesus' name, Amen."
